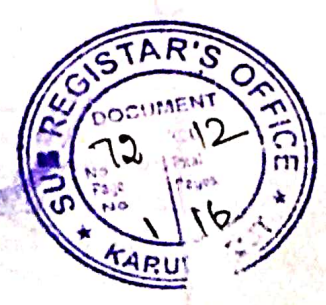
TRUST DEED

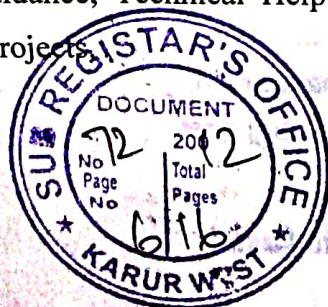

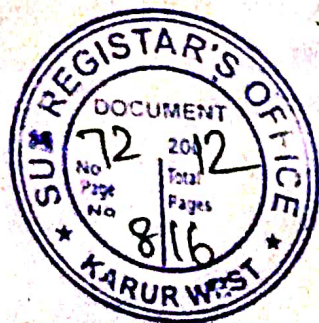

14. To prevent the incidence of drop-outs through sponsorship programme for education of children and educate the existing drop-outs through non formal education and continuing education.
 15. To make the people responsible for their own development by eliciting their participation and involving them in all Programmes.
 16. To motivate people to form self-help groups and Co-operative Societies and encourage them to identify and utilize the locally available resources for their development and that of the community.
 17. To empower the people by facilitating them to discover their personal power to think freely, to make personal choices, to become aware of their needs and respond to them.
 18. To work for the Development of Wasteland Programmes.
 19. To run health Centres, Clinics, Hospitals in the Rural areas for the Development of the Rural Population and to conduct Medical Camps of all nature.
 20. To promote and manage schools, colleges, or other bodies or institutions of all description, including public schools and vocational institutes.
 21. To Start Arts Colleges, Engineering Colleges, Technical Institutions, I.T.I, Medical Colleges, Para Medical Institutions and Computer Education Centres dealing software and hardware and other suitable courses as time and place demand.
 22. To publish books, magazines, periodicals and other literature for the development of education, knowledge and wisdom among the public.
 23. To open libraries, reading rooms and to conduct evening classes and correspondence courses.
 24. To propagate and preserve the Indian culture, traditional Indian crafts, and Indian philosophy and Yoga and Music and Fine Arts.
 25. To undertake Projects concerning conservation of environment by protecting the ecosystem in order to benefit the Rural Poor.

26. To enable the economic development of the people by imparting vocational and self employment training to them and encourage them to be independent by disbursing loans for self employment schemes.
27. To undertake income generating activities for the self-sufficiency of the Trust by promoting Self Help Groups among all poor People.
28. To conduct Seminar, Workshops, Training Programmes, Camps and offer Diploma Courses for the public especially to the staff of NGO and the prospective staff of NGO.
29. To amalgamate or affiliate any other institution whose objects and interest may in any manner directly identifies with and or advancement of the objects or interest of the Trust.
30. To run Hostel for Working Women, Home for the aged, Orphanages, Day Care Centres to help the poor.
31. To grant Scholarships to deserving Students for their education and other needs.
32. To receive gifts, donations and contributions, whether in cash or kind.
33. To do all other acts and deeds which are incidental to the aims and objectives of the Trust

POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES:

- a. The Trustees shall pay, expend or utilise the Trust Fund or such part thereof as they shall in their discretion decide exclusively for all or anyone or more of the objects of the Trust and not for purposes of profit. No part of the income or Corpus Fund shall be employed for any object or purposes other than those of the Trust set out above.
- b. The Board of Trustees shall receive any contribution in the nature of donation, contribution, offerings, and gifts to carry out the objects of the Trust.
- c. It shall be lawful for the Board to frame rules and regulations for the conduct and Management of the Trust.
- d. The Board of Trustees shall determine from time to time the amount it shall spend on the various objects of the Trust.



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The Board shall have power to invest the Corpus or the income of the Trust Fund at their discretion in such investments as may be permitted under the Income-Tax Act.

The Trust should open Bank Accounts with any Scheduled Bank and the operation of the Bank account will be done by MANAGING TRUSTEE OR TRUSTEE OF THE TRUST.

The Administration, Discretion and Management of the properties of the Trust and the Institution and Establishments maintained or run by the Trust hereby created shall, subject to supervision, control and direction of the board, be with the Managing Trustee.

The Board of Trustees shall acquire immovable property of any tenure any where in India with or without buildings and Structures either by way of Purchase, absolutely or by way of lease, exchange, gift or any other form of acquisition as well as to sell, alienate, lease or mortgage at such rates, terms and conditions as the Board of Trustees may deem fit.

i. To construct such building or buildings and structures as may be necessary and from time to time improve, alter, extend or demolish the same or any part thereof and to equip the same with all such amenities and facilities.

j. To maintain a Fund to meet the expenses of Capital nature and to pay into such funds money at such times and in such amounts as the Trustees may decide from time to time.

k. To establish and maintain a Reserve Fund of such amount as the Board of Trustees may think fit for the promotion of activities of the Trust, including the maintenance and support of the Trust.

l. The Board shall have power to sell and dispose of any of the properties of the Trust and apply the proceeds of such sale for and in connection with and or in furtherance of carrying out the objects of the Trust or any institutions that may be established maintained or run by the Trust.

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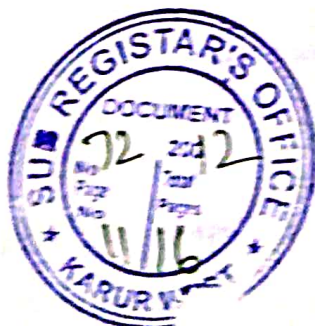
The Trustees shall have powers to accept contributions in money or in the shape of property either by way of addition to the Trust Funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust and such contributions shall be dealt with either as Capital or Revenue according to the direction, if any, of the donor at the time of the gift.

- n. The Board shall have power to call in or convert into cash the Trust properties and realise any or all of the securities and investments and to reinvest and/or dispose of the proceeds.
- o. The Board shall have power to levy any fees or charges from students, apprentices or others benefiting from the institution established, maintained or run by the Trust and to exempt deserving students from payment of any such fees and charges that may be fixed by the Board from time to time.
- p. The Trustees shall have power to apply for and obtain grants-in-aid from the Government or any other constituted authority or body or from any other Agencies/Institutions, Non Governmental Organisations in Foreign Countries who may be interested in contributing to the Trust Funds and settle terms on which such grants may be obtained provided that acceptance of such donations shall not be objectionable under any of the provisions of the Income Tax Law as in force at the time of acceptance of such donations.
- q. Any grants-in-aid received shall be strictly applied for the purposes for which such Grants may have been made.

SPECIFIC POWERS OF MANAGING TRUSTEE:

- i. The Managing Trustee shall, if and when so Authorised by a resolution of the Board, have power and authority for and on behalf of the Board in respect of mortgages or charges to be created for and in connection with obtaining grants-in-aid.

- ii. The Managing Trustee shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper accounts of the receipts and disbursements and of the liabilities incurred and of the assets acquired and place the accounts for Audit every year and for this purpose the Managing Trustee shall appoint in consultation with the Board an independent Auditor.
- iii. Subject to limits contained in the budget sanctioned for the year, the Managing Trustee shall have full authority in applying the moneys allotted and provided under each head for the purposes for which the same have allotted in a manner which, in his discretion, is most advantageous for the institutions and establishments maintained and conducted by the Trust.
- iv. The Managing Trustee shall have power to purchase from time to time, such materials, stationery, furniture etc. that may be necessary for running the said institutions and establishments.
- v. The Managing Trustee shall be the full-fledged executive authority of the Board and empowered to act for and on behalf of the Board and shall have the power and authority jointly and or independently:
 - a. To carry out the resolutions of the Board.
 - b. To sign papers receipts and documents.
 - c. To pay monies due by the Trust and demand and get receipts there of.
 - d. To demand and receive monies due to the Trust and issue receipts for the monies so receive.
 - e. To make, draw, enforce, accept, sign, negotiate or transfer any cheque, promissory note, hundies, bills of exchange, railway receipt, negotiable securities or other securities.
 - f. To borrow funds for implementing or carrying out any of the objects and purposes of the Trust from any Bank, Financial Institutions or private parties on the security by mortgaging or pledging any of the movable and / or immovable properties of the Trust or without security, on such interest and terms and conditions and to execute necessary documents or mortgage deeds on behalf of the Trust for such Borrowings.

- g. To initiate, prosecute, defend, compromise, refer to arbitration or abandon legal proceedings or disputes.
- h. To execute all documents on behalf of the board.
- i. To appoint in consultation with the other trustees, staff, employees and servants for the purpose of running the Trust and the institutions managed and administered by the Trust, to fix their allowances and remuneration, to supervise their work, to take disciplinary action against them, to terminate their services and to appoint others in their place.
- j. To represent the Trust before any Central Government, State Government and other Government undertakings, Local Authorities for all matters concerning the Trust.
- k. Generally do all other acts and things necessary or incidental to the proper day-to-day management of the institutions and establishments maintained and/or conducted by the Trust.
- l. The Managing Trustee and other Trustees shall reimburse themselves or pay of and get reimbursed out of Trust monies in their hands, all expenses properly incurred by them in or about the execution of the Trust and/or in the discharge of the duties imposed on them under this Trust that are chargeable to the expenses of the Trust including honorarium, travelling allowances, transport charges and other expenses incurred by the Trust while carrying out of the objects of the Trust.

ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

The Financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March of the following year excepting the current year in which case the financial year shall be from the date of commencement of the Trust to the 31st March of the following year unless otherwise decided by the Board.

The Accounts of the Trust shall be annually audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees and the Audited Statement of Accounts shall be placed before the Board for its Approval within six months of the close of the financial year.

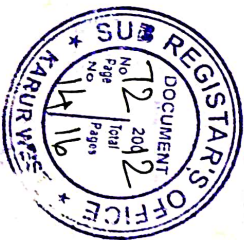
MEETING OF THE BOARD:

- i. The Board shall meet once in Six months.
- ii. The Managing Trustee shall convene the meeting.
- iii. The Board shall transact any business that shall be specified in the agenda or otherwise agreed to by the Board of Trustees.
- iv. The Board shall appoint a qualified Chartered Accountant to audit the accounts of the Trust, at the Annual Meeting, for the subsequent year.
- v. Two Trustees of the Board shall constitute the quorum.
- vi. All decisions shall be carried out by the majority decisions of the Board.
- vii. Any decision in writing signed by all the Trustees shall be binding on the Board of Trustees.
- viii. The Meeting of the Board shall be convened after giving at least a week's notice.
- ix. The Board may invite others interested in the work of the Trust to attend the meetings of the Board but they shall not be entitled to vote.

GENERAL POINTS:

1. The Board may amend the clauses relating to the membership and management of the Trust at a duly convened meeting of the Board by a resolution passed by a majority with at least two weeks notice given for the meeting.
2. That the Investment of the fund of the Trust shall be made in accordance with the provision of section 11(5) read with section 13(1)(d) of the Income Tax Act 1961.
3. Any amendment to the Trust deed shall be carried out with the Prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

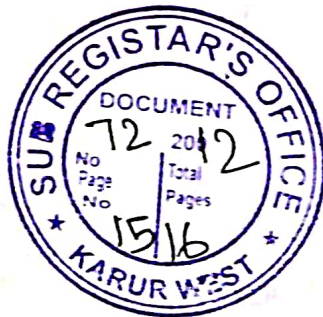

In the event of winding up of the Trust, the Assets of the Trust shall be disbursed to any other Trust or Society having similar objects and in no event they shall be appropriated either by the Trustees or any one related to the Trustees.

5. It is hereby expressly declared that this Trust is a Public Charitable Trust and the Trust hereby declared and created is irrevocable.
6. The Trust is run on Non Profit motive basis and the benefit of the Trust are open to all people irrespective of caste, religion, sex etc.,
7. The objects and activities of the Trust shall be carried out only in India.
8. The amendments if any made to the Trust deed will not extend to alter the basic character / object and no such amendment which may prove to be repugnant to the provision of section 2 (15), 11, 12, 13 & 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961 shall be made.
9. The Income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilised towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilised for payment to the Trustees by way of Profit, Dividend, Interest, etc.,
10. At present the Trust does not own any immovable property other than the Trust Fund and the Trust is run on non-profit motive basis.
